

Subsistence Fisheries Research, Capacity Building, 2001-2003

Abstract: The Alaska Department of Fish and Game Subsistence Division partnered with three regional tribal organizations of the lower, middle and upper Kuskokwim River to provide community-based training for in-season subsistence salmon monitoring and post-season harvest assessment, to strengthen community involvement in local advisory bodies and to support subsistence salmon fisheries management with timely information.
